Triple Camber offers more suspension, extra pop, and unrivaled edge hold over classic rocker profiles—a bit like traditional camber, but without any of the handling tradeoffs in deep and variable snow, a bit like a rockered-twin but with much more planted composure. Sturdy and planted, agile yet stable, powerful but quick—a living contradiction to the statement that you can't have it all, so forgiving yet so capable that it almost feels like cheating.</p>
